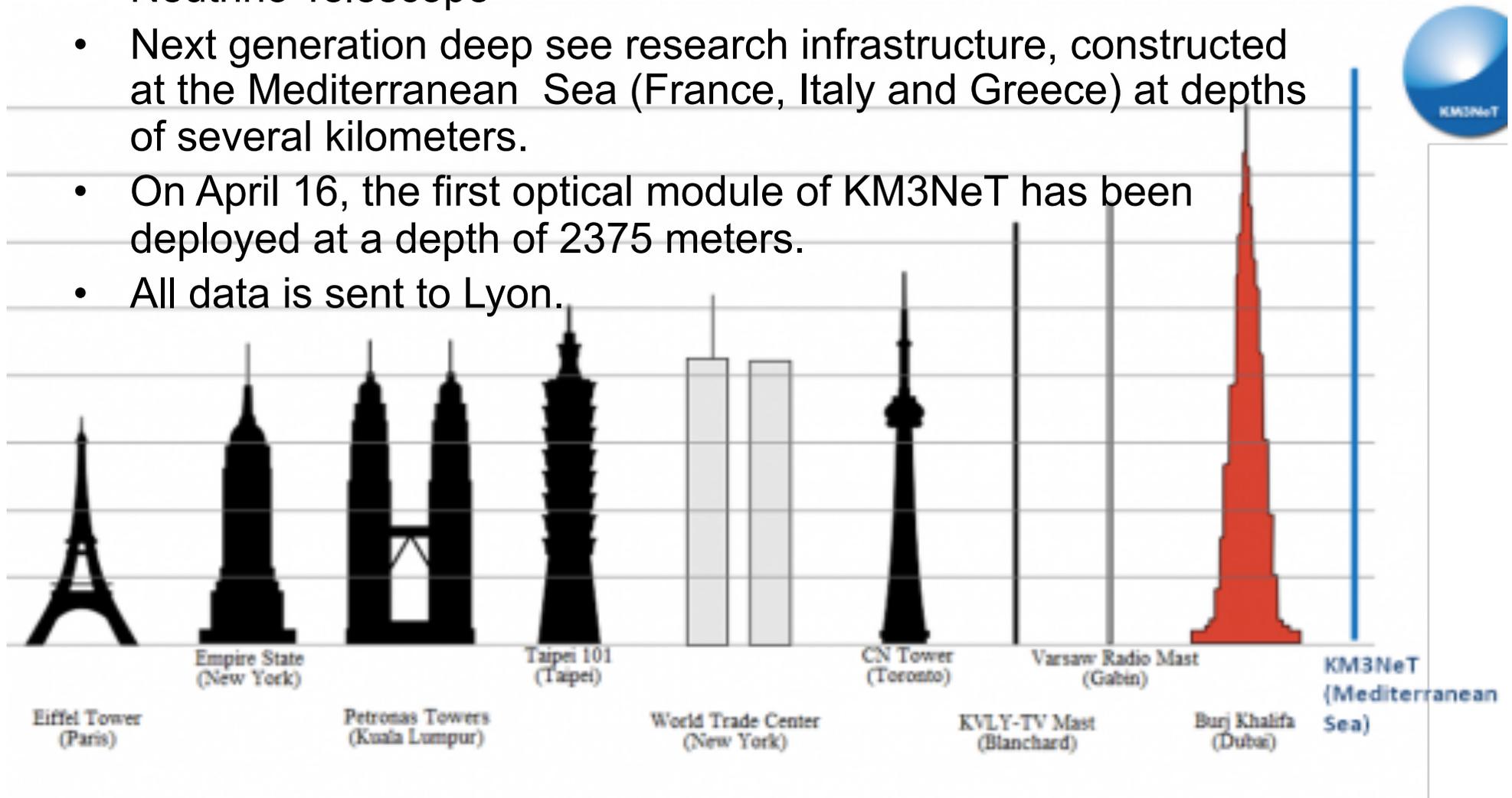




European Grid Infrastructure

KM3NeT

- Neutrino Telescope
- Next generation deep sea research infrastructure, constructed at the Mediterranean Sea (France, Italy and Greece) at depths of several kilometers.
- On April 16, the first optical module of KM3NeT has been deployed at a depth of 2375 meters.
- All data is sent to Lyon.





European Grid Infrastructure

ELIXIR

- European life-science Infrastructure for biological information.
- **MISSION:** Orchestrate the collection, quality control and archiving of large amounts of biological data produced by life science experiments.
- About 17 Countries and EMBL are involved.
